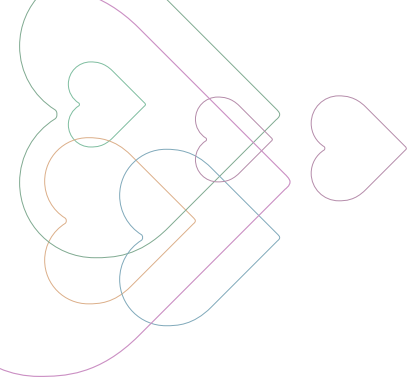
The final agenda of the meeting will be shared in the forthcoming days.

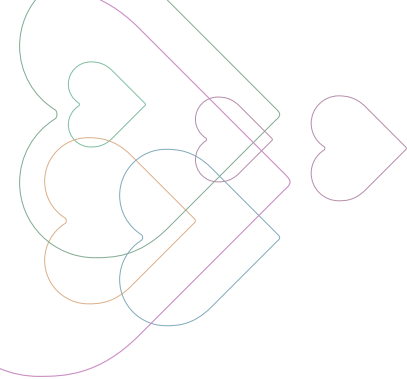
